The Office of the New York State Attorney General's Medicaid Fraud Control Unit is seeking forensic accountants/auditors to participate in complex fraud investigations in the healthcare industry, utilizing the New York State False Claims Act, Social Services Law §145-b, and the Executive Law, and, when appropriate, to support prosecution of crimes uncovered by such investigations. Many of our actions involve coordination with other state and federal civil and prosecutorial anti-fraud agencies resulting in large-scale recoveries.

Candidates for the position of forensic accountant/auditor must possess excellent analytical, communication, and organizational skills, and a minimum of a four (4) year college degree, either specifically in finance, accounting, or economics, or equivalent post-college work experience. Applicants should be proficient with database and presentation software. A CPA is not required; the position qualifies for CPA accreditation purposes. Rating as a certified fraud examiner is a plus. Applicants will be considered for both entry-level and experienced assignments.
