The Office of the New York State Attorney General (“OAG”) is seeking experienced prosecutors to work in the [Division of Criminal Justice](#). The scope of the Division’s work includes bank and financial institution fraud; securities and investment fraud; money laundering; tax crimes; mortgage fraud; insurance fraud; false claims to obtain government money; abuse of authority and government corruption at the state and local levels; and most recently, investigations into the deaths of civilians caused by law enforcement officers. The Division includes attorneys, investigators, auditors and analysts who conduct in-depth, long-term criminal investigations and prosecute cases from charging through conviction.

Candidates must have at **least ten (10) years of prosecutorial experience**. The candidate will also possess excellent writing skills and substantial grand jury and trial experience. A background in investigating and prosecuting homicides and/or official misconduct is highly desirable. A candidate’s assignment/placement within the office will be commensurate with experience.

Applicants must reside in (or intend to soon become a resident of) New York State and be admitted to practice law in New York State. In addition, the Public Officers Law requires that attorneys in the Office be citizens of the United States.

Candidates from diverse backgrounds are encouraged to apply. The OAG is an equal opportunity employer and is committed to workplace diversity.
