Candidates should have a working knowledge of Supreme Court and Surrogate's Court practice and experience handling contested court proceedings, including will proceedings.

Applicants must reside in (or intend to soon become a resident of) New York State and be admitted to practice law in New York State. In addition, Public Officers Law requires that OAG attorneys be citizens of the United States.
