The Office of the New York State Attorney General (OAG) seeks a dedicated, motivated attorney for its [Consumer Frauds and Protection Bureau](#) in New York City. The Bureau conducts investigations and litigates in a variety of areas involving consumer protection. The Bureau enforces consumer protection laws and pursues civil prosecutions against businesses and individuals engaged in fraudulent, misleading, deceptive, or illegal trade practices. Cases typically seek injunctive relief, restitution for consumers, costs and penalties.

Candidates possessing experience in consumer protection and/or affirmative litigation are strongly encouraged to apply. Experience in housing issues, including foreclosure prevention and tenant harassment is a plus. Applicants must possess **a minimum of two (2) years of civil litigation experience**. Excellent writing, analytical and organizational skills are required.

Applicants must reside in (or intend to soon become a resident of) New York State and be admitted to practice law in New York State. In addition, the Public Officers Law requires that attorneys in the Office be citizens of the United States.
