The Office of the New York State Attorney General's (OAG) [Civil Recoveries Bureau](#) is seeking an attorney to serve in the Income Fund Reimbursement (IFR) Unit in Centereach, NY. The IFR Unit recovers money owed for the cost of medical care at SUNY Stony Brook University Hospital.

The IFR Unit is responsible for a large number of hospital accounts and has frequent interactions with the hospital patient accounts staff. Legal work consists of litigation of patient accounts to judgment, including motion practice and judgment enforcement, as well as pursuing claims against estates, hospital liens, and bankruptcy claims.

Candidates should have **at least two (2) years of general civil litigation experience, including trial (jury and bench) experience**. Judgment enforcement and estate practice experience is a plus. Bankruptcy experience and knowledge of Medicaid and Medicare regulations is also a plus.

Applicants must reside in (or intend to soon become a resident of) New York State and be admitted to practice law in New York State. In addition, the Public Officers Law requires that attorneys in the Office be citizens of the United States.
