The Office of the New York State Attorney General (OAG) is seeking an attorney with **strong Korean language skills** to serve in the [Crime Proceeds Strike Force Unit](#) (CPSF) within its Criminal Enforcement and Financial Crimes Bureau located in Manhattan. The CPSF focuses primarily on cases involving bank and financial institution fraud, securities and investment fraud, money laundering, tax crimes, mortgage fraud, investment schemes and insurance fraud. The Unit includes attorneys, investigators, auditors and analysts who conduct in-depth, long-term criminal investigations and prosecute cases from charging through conviction.

The selected candidate will be part of a financial fraud investigative team that is engaged in identifying patterns of fraud in connection with an ongoing international financial crimes investigation. The selected candidate will be responsible for first-line review of emails, reports and financial records; will assist in conducting interviews in Korean; and will write summaries and brief the team on the substance and significance of evidence reviewed on a regular basis. ***This position is for one (1) year term.***

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- Fluency in Korean, including strong reading and writing skills, as well as English; and
- Ability to travel outside of the United States.

Applicants must reside in (or intend to soon become a resident of) New York State and be admitted to practice law in New York State. In addition, the Public Officers Law requires that attorneys in the Office be citizens of the United States.
