For the position of Assistant Attorney General, we are seeking attorneys with a **minimum of eight (8) years** of New York State prosecutorial experience, including significant investigative experience, such as writing search warrants and cell site orders. The ideal candidate will have experience developing and managing complex, document-intensive investigations. The candidate will also possess excellent writing skills and substantial grand jury and trial experience. A background in finance and securities is not necessary, but is a plus.

Attorneys in the Office must reside in (or intend to soon become a resident of) New York State and be admitted to practice law in New York State. In addition, the Public Officers Law requires that attorneys in the Office be citizens of the United States.
