

## **Criminal Investigator: Investigations - Albany**

The Office of the Attorney General is seeking a highly qualified and dynamic candidate for the position of Investigator for the greater Albany, New York region. Candidates should be hard-working, motivated and committed to public service on behalf of the people of the State of New York.

Investigators, under supervision, conduct detailed investigations of the circumstances, facts and conditions connected with complaints and violations of the law, using the highest level of independent judgment and discretion. These are often highly complex and sensitive criminal matters which cross county lines, involve organized crime and public corruption. Successful candidates will combine traditional investigative skills with current technological skills, coupled with strong interpersonal skills and the ability to work in multi-disciplinary teams to bring cases to completion.

This position performs investigations in a wide variety of criminal cases in various bureaus throughout the Office of the Attorney General in the greater Albany region. **The qualifications for this specific position include: A Bachelor's degree from an accredited institution; experience holding the rank of senior investigator or higher; a minimum of 10 years of investigative experience; responsible for overseeing the daily operations of a criminal investigation division; expertise in interviewing and interrogation skills; extensive experience in the investigation of complex confidential and sensitive criminal matters; experience investigating corruption matters, white collar crimes, fraud, narcotics, money laundering, and homicide; experience conducting surveillance operations; experience as an affiant on search warrants as well as executing search warrants; experience as an affiant on eavesdropping warrants, Pen Registers and GPS warrants for cellular telephones and motor vehicles; experience in trial preparation, reviewing case records, interviewing witnesses and serving subpoenas; experience in prisoner extradition; experience in interaction and coordination with other law enforcement agencies; having established law enforcement contacts in the Albany and surrounding counties area.**

### **Qualifications in addition to those listed above:**

Must have current NYS basic police school certification.

Must possess a valid NYS driver's license and have the ability to drive a motor vehicle.

Performance of the duties may require frequent, unscheduled work on evenings and weekends. Appointee will be assigned a Blackberry for possible on-call duty during off-hours.
