The Office of the New York State Attorney General is seeking an experienced prosecutor for the [Public Integrity Bureau](#) (PIB) in either our Buffalo office. PIB Investigates and prosecutes crimes committed by public employees, elected officials, candidates for public office, and people and entities that steal from the government. Prosecutors with PIB handle complex, long term investigations into government corruption, fraud and abuse of authority. PIB investigates and prosecutes both civilly and criminally, from the initial allegation through to settlement, plea, or trial. PIB consists of attorneys, investigators, auditors and analysts.

The ideal candidate will have **at least ten (10) years of legal experience**, including at least five (5) years as a prosecutor, and substantial experience in developing and managing complex, document-intensive investigations. The successful candidate will also possess excellent writing skills and significant grand jury and trial experience. A background in government and policy, and finance and securities, is not necessary but is a plus.

Applicants must reside in (or intend to soon become a resident of) New York State and be admitted to practice law in New York State. In addition, the Public Officers Law requires that OAG attorneys be citizens of the United States.

Candidates from diverse backgrounds are encouraged to apply. The OAG is an equal opportunity employer and is committed to workplace diversity.
