Fall 2015/Spring 2016 Internships – Statewide Volunteer Undergraduate & Graduate (Non-Law) Students

The Office of the New York State Attorney General (“OAG”) has part-time internship positions for volunteers or externships for course credit open for the 2015/2016 academic year for undergraduate and graduate students. These positions are available statewide within the Divisions of Criminal Justice, Economic Justice, Social Justice, State Counsel, Appeals and Opinions, and the Regional Offices. Students are needed to assist professional and support staff in all phases of their work including but not limited to: non-legal research; data entry; drafting of correspondence and memos; assisting with consumer complaint intake and mediation; and performing clerical tasks such as filing, answering telephones, scheduling meetings. We are seeking bright, hardworking students who are committed to public service and have excellent research and writing skills; fluency in other languages (e.g., Spanish, Mandarin, Russian, Korean, etc.) in addition to English is a plus, but not required.

Students selected for an internship or externship with the OAG will be assigned to one of the bureaus in the main offices in Manhattan or Albany, or to one of our smaller regional offices located in Binghamton, Brooklyn, Buffalo, Harlem, Hauppauge, Mineola, Plattsburgh, Poughkeepsie, Rochester, Syracuse, Utica, Watertown or White Plains. Applicants should only apply for those bureaus and/or regional offices of interest to them. Location preferences will be honored; however, bureau assignment may ultimately be made based upon the needs of the office.

The individuals who are selected for these positions must be full-time students. Interns commit to work part-time (15 hours/week).

Click on the link for the Fall/Spring (make sure you are accessing the link for undergraduate & graduate students), then click the bureau or regional office of interest; applicants will be taken to the online application page for that particular intern position.

Applicants must be prepared to submit a cover letter, resume, most recent school transcript (*unofficial is acceptable*), writing sample, and the contact information for three (3) references including email addresses. **Please Note: Failure to submit a complete application will delay the consideration of your application.***

- **Indicate in the cover letter whether the application is for the Fall 2015 or Spring 2016.**
- Please apply to **no more than 5 bureaus/regional offices**. Applications are submitted separately for each bureau/regional office and applicants will be notified of the decision on each application.
- Upon submission of an application, you will have the opportunity to apply for other available openings in different bureaus/regional offices.
- If applying to multiple bureaus/regional offices, we recommend that you submit the same cover letter for **each** application, ranking those bureaus/regional offices in order of your preference.
