The Office of the Attorney General is seeking a qualified candidate for a Detective Investigator position in the location noted above. Candidates should be hard-working, motivated, and committed to public service on behalf of the people of the State of New York.

Investigators, under supervision, work with attorneys to conduct detailed investigations of the circumstances, facts and conditions connected with complaints and violations of the law, using the highest level of independent judgment and discretion. These are often highly complex and sensitive criminal matters which cross county lines and involve white collar crimes.

**Minimum Qualifications:**

- Must have at least ten (10) years of prior law enforcement experience.
- Have current NYS basic police academy certification approved by DCJS or the ability to successfully complete all requirements to obtain NYS basic police academy certification.
- Must possess a valid NYS Driver's License with ability to operate a motor vehicle.
- The Public Officer's Law requires that police officers at the OAG be citizens of the United States and reside in New York State.
- Expert interviewing and interrogation skills.
- Extensive experience in the investigation of all types of criminal activity including white-collar crim.
- Experience investigating confidential and sensitive matters, such as those dealing with cooperating witnesses and undercover operations.
- Experience conducting surveillance and executing search warrants.
- Experience testifying as a witness.
- Experience utilizing various computer systems.
- Experience working with other law enforcement agencies.
- Having established regional contacts at the city, state and federal levels.

**The annual salary for this position is \$77,608. Appointments in New York City receive an additional \$4,000 location pay.** This position is overtime eligible. Performance of the duties may require frequent, unscheduled work on evenings and weekends and requires 24/7 availability. This position is in the exempt class, and incumbents serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General.
